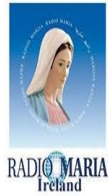

BALTINGLASS TIDY TOWNS COMMITTEE

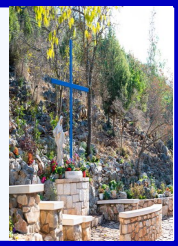
