On this third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday, we ask ourselves: 'What is Joy?'

The words of the Catholic Priest and writer Henri Nouwen give us a good insight into what we mean by Christian joy.

He writes that:

'Joy is the experience of knowing that you are unconditionally loved [by God] and that nothing—sickness, failure, emotional distress, oppression, war, or even death—can take that love away. Joy is not the same as happiness. We can be unhappy about many things, but joy can still be there because it comes from the knowledge of God's love for us....'

He goes on to write:

'Joy does not simply happen to us. We have to choose joy and keep choosing it every day. It is a choice based on the knowledge that we belong to God and have found in God our refuge and our safety and that nothing, not even death, can take God away from us.'

As we ready ourselves to celebrate the coming of Christ, may these words of wisdom speak to us today. May we remember that joy does not simply happen to us. We have to choose joy and keep choosing it every day, firm in the knowledge of God's love for us.

Today's antiphon of the Mass proclaims: 'Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near. Let us hear the Advent call to rejoice, let's choose joy.'

Help us to see in the Christ-child we welcome this Christmas, the one who came to bring an end to all divisions & injustice. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.


